The last Quarterfinals session & the 3-session Semi Finals were played yesterday in the Team of Four event.

In the 3*12 boards Quarter Finals, **Dhampur Sugar Mills** beat Andrey (Andrey Purushottam, P D Joshi, P Khadloya, Dr Vahalia, Col. Satish Diwanjee) in a one-sided match by a huge margin of 109 IMPs; **Khandelwal** beat Promila Saraf (Mrs. Promila Saraf, P. Sudhakara Rao, C.S. Majumder, Deepak Santra, Alok Daga, Mrinal Mukherjee) by 23 IMPs; **Manyavar** beat Azure (Maj. Surender Hooda, Sandip Datta, Kaustabh Nandi, Kaustubh Bendre, Ashok Vaidya, Vinay Desai) by 47 IMPs and **Formidables** beat Hands & Hearts (Mrs. Hema Deora, N Rajmohan, Nirmal Jain, Ravi Dudhane, T V Ramani) by 22 IMPs. It will be an icing on the cake for the Dhampur Sugar Mills team, which is going to represent India in the forthcoming World Championship at Veldhovan in Oct 2011, if they win the tournament but Manyawar – a very good team of bridge veterans will not make it easy for their opponents and each imp will be fought tooth and nail.

The 32 Pair all-play-all final will also be played today morning. Pairs will play the 62 boards final with Barometer scoring.

OPEN PAIRS

173 pairs participated in the first elimination round of the Open Pairs event. They were put in six sections and after playing 2 sessions of 22 boards each, 70 qualified Pairs (17 TOP NS & 17 TOP EW pairs each from combined sections "A", "B" & "C" and 18 TOP NS & 18 TOP EW pairs from combined section "D", "E" & "F" went through to the 2^{nd} elimination round. They were joined in the 2^{nd} elimination round by 8 of the losing quarterfinalists' pairs of the team event. The 1^{st} elimination leaders were:
