WHAM and OLIMP to Clash in the GOLD Final

On Sunday, 12th October, the Semi-Finals of the GOLD category at the 22nd HCL International Bridge Championship delivered two contrasting stories. **WHAM** (Sartaj Hans, Andy Hung, Michael Whibley, and Matthew Brown) overcame **EA Bridge** (Kavita Singhania, Koushik Mukherjee, Priya Ranjan Sinha, Badal Das, Shibnath De Sarkar, Pranab Bardhan) 148.5–117 in a match that was balanced early but tilted steadily WHAM's way over the next two sets. **OLIMP** (Andrey Gromov, Anna Gulevich, Sergey Orlov, Evgeny Rudakov, Olga Firsova), meanwhile, broke open their clash against **Monica Jajoo's team** (Monica Jajoo, Sukamal Das, Binod Shaw, Sanjit Dey, Kaustubh Bendre, and Sayanta Kushari) with a commanding **75–15 third set**, sealing a 155–107 victory. The final set was a mere formality as both winners cruised comfortably to Monday's final showdown.

The **GOLD Final** begins at **9:00 AM**, an hour earlier than usual — fittingly so, as two in-form powerhouses prepare for what promises to be a battle of precision and nerve.

In the **SILVER** category, **Nagpur VI** (Arun J Puranik, Sameer Roy, Mahesh Mor, Anil Kumar Mohota, Makrand M Luley) outplayed **ERNIS** (Santanu Chakraborty, Jibak Tewari, Sumita Dasgupta, Chandan Kumar Mitra, Arun Kumar Majhi) 156–123, while **Hyderabad Blue** (R P Narain, D Sudhanand, Prabhat Kumar Gupta, Akhauri Prabhat Kumar) got past **Ashok Bedi** (Ashok Bedi, Rakesh Nanda, B S Gupta, Rohit Gupta) 131.67–114 to set up a well-contested final.

In the MP Pairs, the third elimination saw Diego Brenner and Paul D. Hackett top the field with 2323.56, narrowly ahead of Rajeshwar Tewari – Sumit Mukherjee on 2319.92. Sandeep Thakral – Subhash Gupta (2283.09) and Wojciech Gawel – Piotr Marcinowski (2280.37) followed close behind. The Final begins at 9:30 AM.

In IMP Pairs Elimination, Mrinal Kanti Mukherjee and Sowmik Das led the pack with +124 IMPs, while N. Periaswamy and B. Seenivasagan were just a step behind on +105 IMPs.



Semi-Finals Set 1

Both the GOLD category semi-finals were on the VU graph on Sunday 12thOctober, 2025 morning. WHAM played against EA Bridge and Monica Jajoo faced OLIMP. First two boards were flat. The third board led to a game swing in both the matches.

Both North's reached $4 \triangleq$ and got \mathbf{Q} lead. In the Open Room, three suits had been bid, in the Closed Whibley rightly chose to lead from his shorter minor. Both Declarers ducked once and won the second round of Diamonds with the \mathbf{A} , played a Spade to Dummy's \mathbf{A} , and cashed \mathbf{A} AK to discard two Clubs.

Hung played a Diamond next. Shibnath was out of trumps when he won the Diamond trick. Hung was able to ruff his fourth Diamond and claim 10 tricks. Defenders got the fourth Spade. In the Closed Room, Koushik played the ♣8 after cashing Hearts. He had to lose a trump and a Diamond more. Team WHAM won 10 IMPs on the board.





In the OLIMP vs. Monica Jajoo match, both Easts led the $\clubsuit Q$. In the Open Room, Gromov ducked, won Spade shift with the $\spadesuit Q$, discarded two Diamonds on $\blacktriangledown AK$, cashed $\clubsuit A$, andl ruffed a Club. He only lost a Diamond and the fourth Trump. $4 \spadesuit$ made four for +420.

In the Closed Room, Sayantan won the \triangle A first time, went to Dummy with the \triangle Q, discarded a Club on \bigvee A, ruffed a Heart, and played the \triangle A. It is difficult to figure out what he was trying to achieve. The details of further play are not available. The contract went down one. OLIMP won 10 IMPs as a result.



The next board produced a swing the other way in the WHAM vs EA Bridge match. Hung's $3\clubsuit$ overcall showed Spades and Diamonds. Sartaj Hans bid $4\spadesuit$ on Kahchu's $4\blacktriangledown$ and Chotan bid $5\blacktriangledown$. Hung doubled and led the \spadesuit A. It turned out to be the wrong Ace to lead. That allowed the Declarer to discard a Club on \spadesuit K. Defenders only got two Aces. $5\blacktriangledown$ doubled, made, was worth 850.

In the Closed Room, Koushik bid 2♥ over 1♥, the Michaels Cue-bid showing Spades and a minor. East jumped to 4♥ and South bid 4♠. Brown doubled. Koushik passed, but the bidding recorded on the Vu graph shows he redoubled. East passed. With six Hearts, he could well have taken an insurance with a 5♥ bid, however, he trusted partner to have enough defence for the double. Indeed, he did have enough. West cashed two top Clubs and continued Clubs. With no entry to the Closed hand to take the trump finesse, the Declarer lost the ♠K and a Diamond more. One down was 200 to East-West (the score is recorded right, but not the bidding), but the East-West in the OR had collected 850, so EA Bridge won 12 IMPs on the board.





In the OLIMP-Monica Jajoo match, the bidding followed a similar pattern. Sanjit Dey did not double. 4♠ went one down. In the Closed Room, West, surprisingly, pushed North-South to five Spades level with a 5♥ bid. He then doubled and extracted 300. That was five IMPs to OLIMP.





Board five produced yet another swing. That was in favour of the WHAM team. In the Open Room, Hung opened his 11-pointer with a 1♦ bid. East-West don't seem to have a method to handle this type of hand. With 19 HCP, East passed. With seven, West balanced. In the chaotic sequence that followed these bids, East-West ended up in 3Nt without any one of them mentioning the Spade suit. On a Club lead, it went down three. The Closed Room bidding was routine. North passed and East-West had an undisturbed auction to 4♠. Brown made 11 tricks for +450 and WHAM registered a 12-IMP gain.




In the other match, it was a flat board. Boards 6,7,8were flattish. Board nine to 11 brought up a swing each in the WHAM-EA Bridge match. On Board 9, Hung opened 1♣ strong, Kachchu overcalled 1♠, and Sartaj responded 1Nt potentially exposing partner's lower Diamond honours to trouble on the Opening lead. The reached 3Nt, West led a Diamond, and the contract was set up for defeat on trick one itself. Sartaj won ♠ A on the third round and finessed Spades. On the run of Diamonds, he had to let go a Spade from the North hand because ♣AQ were needed to ward off a Club shift. He then used the ♥A entry for another Spade finesse. That lost and he lost one more trick to ♣King. Down three for 150 to East-West was the result.



In the other room, Whibley doubled North's $1 \triangleq$ opening on an Ace-less hand and corrected the $2 \triangleq$ takeout to $2 \spadesuit$. Perhaps, it is part of a coded system. North doubled $2 \spadesuit$ for takeout and Priya passed. It went down two for 500 to North-South. EA Bridge earned 12 IMPs on the board.

On Board 10, EA Bridge won nine more IMPs. It was because of the not so infrequent problem that a wide range one level opening gets into. Kachchu upgraded his hand perhaps because of the two Ten-spots in Majors, and opened a 20-21 2Nt holding only 19 HCP. A Club lead would have beaten that contract by a trick, but Sartaj didn't have a crystal ball. He led the fourth best of his longest suit. Kachchu won and played a Heart. A Club switch would have put declarer under pressure, but Sartaj now shifted to the • Queen. Kachchu won and played another Heart. Sartaj won and continued Spades Hung ducking once more. Kachchu now cashed top Diamonds and cashed Hearts ending in Dummy. The diagram below on the right, shows the 4-card position.






At the other Table, Whibley opened 1♣ and everyone passed. Priyaranjan Sinha led a top Heart. Declarer collected only five tricks. EA Bridge earned 9 IMPs on the board.

On Board 11, Sartaj Hans opened and Chotan bid $2 \, - \, +$, weak, with his six moth-eaten Spades. Hung doubled and Kachchu happily jumped to $4 \, - \, +$. Sartaj Passed suggesting that he was OK with a higher level contract. $4 \, - \, +$ went Pass- Pass to Hung who took out to 4Nt suggesting length in both minors. Sartaj now bid $5 \, - \, +$ and played in $5 \, - \, +$ undoubled. He had to lose three Hearts. Down one was the result.



In the Closed Room, after a similar beginning to the auction, Koushik doubled 4♠ rather than bidding 4Nt. Perhaps, there was some misunderstanding about the meaning of South's Pass on 4♠. Anyway, Priyaranjan Sinha sat for the double. Declarer had only three losers. 4♠ doubled made was +590 to East-West. Team WHAM earned 11 IMPs on the board.




Last three boards were push boards in the WHAM-EA Bridge match. WHAM started with a carry over of 8. The session score was 37-37. WHAM led 45-37 at the end of the first set.

In the OLIMP vs. Monica Jajoo match, every board in the second half of the first set produced a swing. We will have a look at the three bigger swings starting with board nine. In the Open Room, North-South reached 3Nt in an uncontested auction. Sanjit Dey led fourth best \$47 from his longest and strongest suit.



Anna Gulevich played small from Dummy and Binod Shaw won with the ♣T. He now switched to a small Diamond that went to Dummy's ♦ Queen. Anna got to the Closed hand with the ♥A and ran the ♠9. Binod won ♠J and drove out the ♦Ace. Anna finessed Spades again. Binod won and cashed his Diamonds. 3Nt went down two for 100 to East-West.


In the Closed Room, Sayantan opened 1 ♠ and after a similar sequence to that in the OR, South played in 3Nt. The Opening lead was the same: ♣7. Kaustubh inserted the ♣Q winning the trick. He also played a Heart to ♥A and ran the ♠9 but he was a tempo ahead. Olga Firsova won ♠Jack and advanced ♦ Jack. That went to Dummy's Queen. Kaustubh now played the Spades off the top. He made nine tricks for +400. Monica Jajoo team won eleven IMPs as a result. Their team had lost 25 IMPs in first eight boards. Board nine marked their come back.

On Board 10, they added 8 IMPs. Like Kachchu in the other match, Binod opened 2Nt upgrading his 19-HCP hand. All passed. Like Sartaj, Anna Gulevich led her fourth best Diamond. Binod won and played \P T. Anna won and shifted to a small Spade where Sartaj had chosen the \P Q shift. Gromov won the \P 7 shift with the \P A and returned a Spade. Binod finessed. Anna won the \P Q and played another Spade whereupon Binod drove out the \P K. Club finesse gave Binod his eighth trick. 2Nt scored +120.




The bidding in the Closed room brought up the other shortcoming of a wide range 1♣ opening. In the WHAM-EA Bridge match, East had passed 1♣ and East-West had played in a 3-2 Club fit going down two. In the OLIMP-Monica Jajoo match, East chose to respon 1♥ holding only 3 HCP. Olga Firsova now jumped to 3♦ to show a 4-card Heart fit and 18-19 HCP with a balanced hand. Orlov reverted to 3♥.

Sayantan led \blacklozenge J. Declarer won \blacklozenge Q and played a trump. Kaustubh won and gave partner a Diamond ruff by playing the \blacklozenge 6. Hehad played the \blacklozenge 7 or the first trick. Sayantan ruffed and played the \clubsuit J. Normally, \blacklozenge 6 should be read as asking for the higher suit, Spades here, but the Declarer perhaps missed the spot card, or chose not to believe South. Orlov went up with the \clubsuit A and played another trump. He lost two Spades and the \clubsuit K in addition. $3 \checkmark$ went down two for 200 to North-South. Monica Jajoo team won 8 IMPs on the board.



Board 13 was the last big swing of the set. In the Open Room, Binod opened 1 \clubsuit and South pre-empted 3 \blacktriangledown . Sanjit bid 3 \spadesuit . Binod rebid 4 \spadesuit to show a strong minor two-suiter. Sanjit reverted to 5 \spadesuit . \blacktriangledown King was led. Binod won \blacktriangledown A, cashed \spadesuit A discarding a Heart, took the trump finesse, cashed \clubsuit A, and claimed 12 tricks when everyone followed to two Diamonds. East-West scored +620.



In the Closed Room, Olga Firsova chose to open 1♦. After 2♥ by South and 2♠ by West, Orga Firsova rebid 3♣. West passed because the 3♣ could have come with a 2254 hand with just 12-13 HCP or so whereas East had a 3-loser blockbuster. Firsova made the same 12 tricks that the Declarer made in the other room. That was 170 to East-West. Monica Jajoo won 10 IMPs on the board.



In last eight boards, Monica Jajoo scored as many as 35 IMPs. At the end of Set 1, they were leading OLIMP 35-23. The Vu graph records show 25 for OLIMP.
