

## **Poland, Mavericks All Stars, Formidables in the QF as expected**

The first Knockout Round of the HCL International Bridge Tournament 2023 got over today. Poland, Mavericks All Stars, Formidables, and Joyjits Army each won their pre-QF matches with a big margin while the other four games were more evenly contested. Two matches - Rampage vs. Hemant Jalan and Delhi Blues vs. Tornatae went to the wire. In each case, the winning margin was 3 IMPs. Hemant Jalan team and Delhi Blues were the winners. Other two teams to reach the quarter-finals are Bulgaria and Azs Buboslavia. Tomorrow's main attraction will be the contest between Poland and Mavericks All Stars.

## Maverick Prodigies vs. Poland

The young team of Maverick Prodigies qualified on the 16<sup>th</sup> spot after 10 rounds yesterday. Poland topped the Swiss League. Poland had the first choice of opponent. As expected, they chose Maverick Prodigies. The first two sets of the match saw a close contest. In fact, at the end of the first two sets, the youngsters were leading 70-68. They had two big gains in the first set.

Both tables played 3Nt on Board 10. In the Closed Room, Anshul Bhatt got a lead of ♥J. He now had enough tempo to develop nine tricks. Maverick Prodigies got 11 IMPs on this board.

The bidding was straightforward in the Closed Room. East led ♥J. Anshul won with the ♥K, played a ♠ to ♠K and finessed Clubs losing to ♣Q. Defender had at most four tricks. +600 for North-South.

In the Open Room, West lead the ♦Q. Declarer won, cashed ♣A, ♣AK and finessed ♣ went down one.

On Board 12, the youngsters bid a Grand Slam whereas the Poland East-West ended up in a small slam. Maverick Prodigies got 12 IMPs as a result.

The Diamond suit interference made it difficult for East-West to get all the necessary information across and they settled in 6♠. In the other room, there was no interference. The absence of a 4♦ cue bid over 4♣ made it abundantly clear that East's three key cards were ♠AK and ♥A. East-West reached the laydown Grand Slam and Maverick prodigies got 11 IMPs.

On Board 17 of second set, Anindra Kumar Sarkar of Maverick Prodigies smelt out an adverse trump break judging from the enquiries about the auction.

At his turn, and before the Opening lead, West enquired about the bidding and made a couple of repeated enquiries about the 5♣ response. That made Anindra suspect that the Trumps were behaving badly. West eventually led a small Club. Anindra won in hand and tabled ♠A drawing ♠8 from East. That card confirmed his suspicions. At trick three, Anindra ran the ♠7 winning the trick and making his contract. In the other room, Poland North-South had finished in 6♠ with two Key Cards out. The contract duly went two down. That was 11 IMPs to Maverick Prodigies.

The third session began quietly. As the game progressed, the Poland team collected IMPs in double digit increments. Let us look at some of those boards and try to see where the experience of the Poland team carried them to a better bidding spot or a better card in the play.

EW missed a Heart fit and a game here...even a slam would have good percentage but is hard to visualise. The bidding was identical in both the rooms for first five bids. In both the rooms, the dbl of 1Nt showed a Major and a minor and North's 2♥ bid showed Spades.

In the Open Room, Joyrup passed throughout although he held 10 HCP opposite a bid. South bid 2♠ and West got in yet again with a 3♣ follow-up that was passed out. The Poland East in the Closed room straightaway bid 3♥ that was raised by West to 4. Poland won eight IMPs on that board.

Sabyasachi-Joyrup missed a slam on board 4 as the following auction shows. East's ♣A ♦K were covering two of West's three losers, the Trumps were Solid, and there were no fast losers. It seems that Joyrup's Club suit dissuaded Savyasachi from a slam try fearing wasted Club values. In the other room Poland East bid 2♥ which would show a Heart suit and three or more controls as per their convention. West knew it right away. There was no science after that. East bid 6Nt just in case. All was well that ended well and the slam came home for a 13 IMP gain.

Anshul-Eliran missed a Game on Board 6. Poland NS had an uncontested run to the game when Joyrup did not open his 11 pointer. In the Close Room, South doubled East's 1♦ opening and doubled 3♦ next in the balancing position. Anshul had an uninspiring 4423 with just 6 HCP. He could have bid 4♦ here to get to a Major suit game. South's strength isn't very evident from the balancing double but note that as the cards were there were 11 tricks, not 10. This was a loss of 7 IMPs.

The next board, board 7 was another game swing. This time, Anshul-Eliran landed in a 5♦ contract with three Aces out. The full bidding was.

Anshul did not bid 3Nt on 3♦ with a Spade void and a 4-

carder fit. Pszczola doubled and Eliran redoubled. The contract always goes down on a trump lead but West found a Heart lead. Had Eliran played carefully ruffing three Spades in Dummy, he would have made the redoubled contract. As it was, he seems to have lost his concentration and played a small Heart on trick 1. Down one was the result.

That was not the only redoubled contract in the set. On board 10, Maverick Prodigies lost 2000 in another Diamond contract. We shall not go into the details of later boards. The final score for the third session of the match was 85-9.

## A subtle show-up and the only chance

Even since my book 'Easier Done Than Said' (Master Point Press, 1998) showcased a simple deal play by Abhay Todankar, I always ask him if he has played any hand well in the near past. He never fails to come up with some interesting hand after almost every tournament. HCL 2023 International Bridge Championship was no exception.



Abhay reached 5♥ on this hand before they found out that a slam was out of reach. West led a small Club. Abhay won and played the ♥AK and back. East won and played the ♦King. To make, Abhay had to play the Spade suit without any loser. He won the ♦A, cashed on trump East throwing a Club, and conceded a small Diamond. West won and played a Club. Abhay won and cashed his last trump East throwing the ♦Queen this time.

It was clear that he was most likely holding on to Jack to four Spades. If those were ♠J9xx, the contract was going to go down. In the last four-card holding, the only chance to make was to find West with 97 doubleton of Spades. Abhay therefore played a Spade to the Queen and ran the ♠9. That won the trick and Abhay made his contract.



## Bindiya Le Gayi

Connoisseurs of Indian Music must have heard the famous Thumri that begins 'Bindiya Le Gayi'. That thumri came to life today on Table in the match Tornatae vs Delhi Blues. The match went to wire in the fourth set after a see-saw battle.

Tell me about the battles you won, I said to a beaming Bindiya as we walked away from the playing arena. This is the deal she gave me.

On 2♥, not wanting to forgo the opportunity of conducting the hand, Bindiya forced with a 3♣ rebid. Tushar duly bid 3♠ and they reached 4♠ game that made easily. In the Open Room, East chose to bid 4♥. That went down for a good 12 IMPs to Delhi Blues, Bindiya's team. She didn't tell me about the double but the scoresheet did.

The Thumri lyrics describe the excuse of a fish stealing Bindiya – a dot worn on forehead, but what we have here is Bindiya stealing IMPs from the opponents. Delhi Blues won the match 120-117. The session scores are elsewhere in the bulletin.


