The contract was the same on both tables. A trump was led in the open room. Now declarer can make 11 tricks if he unblocks the spade Ace-Jack and reenters hand with a trump. The trumps break. He throws two hearts on the Spade KQ, concedes a heart and ruffs the last one on the table. On any red suit lead declarer is held to ten tricks.

A spade lead will scuttle the contract. Whenever East gains lead with the Club Ace, he can push pack a spade through South's king giving the defense 4 spade tricks. Nystrom dully led a spade. Declarer misguessed the club position by leading a low club and putting up dummy's king to go one more down.

On the other table Sementa led the H6. Declarer won in hand and played a low club two dummy's... Jack. **He got it right!** With a sure short club entry, West might have led a spade. A spade lead would give the declarer no chance.

In the open room Zwederland played 4H. With the black Aces and a diamond to lose, declarer will have to be clairvoyant to hook the hearts. Cash even one top heart - game over. In the Close Room, Zwederland, overshot to 4S which got whacked. The red Aces and 2 clubs. If declarer can hook the trump queen it is still -200. He misguessed for down 2.

But one doesn't know for sure how destructive the preempt can be these days.

In the Open Room Lavazza overshot to 5S, which was not doubled. East led the club jack and continued clubs which

declarer ruffed. He played a diamond. East won the Ace and shifted to the king of HK. Nystrom over took with the Ace and backed a club. North ruffed with the Ace and hoping for spades two-one, played the queen. Spades didn't break. East had to get a spade trick -500. Two down.

In the Closed Room, North was playing 4S. Bocchi, led the CJ, which held. He shifted to a trump. Declarer won in hand and played a diamond which Bocchi ducked. Declarer won on the table and continued diamond queen on which he threw a heart. East won the Ace and played a club which declarer ruffed, played a spade to the king. On the DJ he threw his 2nd heart. 4H made. Zwederland did well to bid 5H to push Lavazza over, and pick up another 13 Imps.

In the Closed Room, North being void in spades and a 4-4-5 and with 9 points passed his partners 1S opening! He took a view.

In the Open Room, North bid a forcing no trump, found the 4-4-heart fit and stretched to game. West led a diamond to declarer's king. Declarer played his singleton club to dummy's queen which east won. He tried to scuttle the cross ruff by shifting to a trump. West won the heart Ace and continued a trump. Declarer won in hand and ruffed a spade on the table, ruffed a club in hand, dropping East's Ace. He cashed the diamond queen and played a diamond to dummy's Ace. On the 13th diamond East ruffed while Duboin threw a spade. Declarer won the spade Ace (East had only spades to lead) and ruffed a spade on the table dropping West's king. On the Club queen he threw a spade, ruffed a club in hand. The spade queen was the tenth trick. Well played. Lavazza pulled back 7 Imps. What if East doesn't return a trump when in with the club Ace? But that's another story.

They won the 2nd set 39-26 Imps to lead by 17 Imps at the halfway mark.
