ALL INDIA *HCL* BRIDGE TOURNAMENT 12th to 15th August 2006 HOTEL RADISSON, NOIDA

The 4th All India HCL Bridge Tournament with total prize money of approximately 9.7 lacs was held at Hotel Radisson, NOIDA from 12th to 15th August 2006. It is the first time that the tournament was held under the auspices of **Contract Bridge Association**.

The Tournament had 2 events - the Team of Four event for the "Naresh Tandan Trophy" and the Open Pairs event for the "Neena Bonerjee Trophy". Total 62 Teams & 144 Pairs comprising players from all over India along with the DATA STEEL team from Karachi, Pakistan, participated in the Team of Four & Open Pairs tournament,. Formidables, Tolani Shipping, Dhampur Sugar Mills, SHREE RADHEY, J.P. Goenka, Alok Daga, MONOTONA and Manyavar were some of the top participating teams.

Team of Four Event for "Naresh Tandan Trophy":

Round Robin Stage:

The event comprised of 10 rounds of round robin (each 10 boards) resulting in the top 8 teams to qualify for the quarterfinals. At the end of first day (after 6 rounds of round robin), **DELHI BLUES**, a local team of Delhi comprising of D.K. Tewari, P.C. Gupta, Paresh Gupta, Amarjit Wadhawan, Mahendra Singh and Arun Jain led the event with **118 VPs**. **SHREE RADHEY** (V.M. Lal, P. Bafana, Ashok Vaidya, R. Bhiwandkar) **& MAHARAJA** (S. Lahiri, A. Kundu, S. Sengupta, S. Pal, M.K. Mukherjee, K. Choudhury) shared the second place with **115 VPs**. Maya Mira Sneha (113), Formidables (111), Pankaj Mehta (110), J.P. Goenka (110) & Kamlesh Gupta's IV (110) held the 4th to 8th positions respectively.

After playing 4 more rounds on the second day, **Dhampur Sugar Mills** Team (Ashok Goel, Kamal Mukherjee, Kamal Roy, Debashish Roy, Sandeep Thakral & R. Venkatesh) with **190 VPs**, topped the 10 round - Round-Robin stage, to finalize the quarter-finalists. **SHREE RADHEY** (V.M. Lal, P. Bafana, Ashok Vaidya & Raju Bhiwandkar) with **187 VPs** were second. The quarter finalists were:

In the second semi-final, Manas Saha's IV (Manas Saha, Snehashish Roy, Debabrata Majumder, Santanu Chowdhury, Pranab Roy, Kaustabh Nandi) beat Shree Radhey (V.M. Lal, R.G. Bhiwandkar, P. R. Bafna, Ashok Vaidya) by 124-69 (28-35, 35-24, 61-10)

Team of Four Final:

It was J.P. GOENKA Vs. MANAS SAHA's IV in the 4*16 boards FINALS of Team of Four event.

In the 4*16 boards final, **J.P. GOENKA** beat **MANAS SAHA's IV** by **150 - 109 (39-34, 61-37, 20-29, 30-9).** J.P. Goenka's team was leading by a solitary 5 IMPs margin in the first set but in the second set, they consolidated their position with another 24 IMPs to lead by 29 IMPs at half-way stage. Manas Saha's team was able to recover back 9 Imps in the 3rd set and the match was well poised for the final set with Goenka's team leading with 20 IMPs. However, there was no more hiccups and the strong Goenka team added a further 21 IMPs to won the match by 41 IMPs.

OPEN PAIRS Event for "Neena Bonerjee Trophy"

144 pairs participated in the Open Pairs event. These pairs went through two grueling eliminations rounds.

Elimination – 1: In the first elimination 124 Pairs (excluding the qualified pairs for the T-4 event) participated.
