

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Aggressive at 1st level with either shape or strong suit
Sound at 2nd level
RESP: new suit at 2nd level=NF; 1NT=8-12HCP
Over 1M: CUE=GF; 2NT=LIMIT RAISE; JUMP CUE=MIXED R
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-17HCP RESP: (1m)-1NT system on
(1M)-1NT: 2♣=D, 2♦=OM, 2M=STAY, 2OM=♣, 2NT=NAT
REOPEN: (1m)-p-(p)=15-17HCP, system on
(1M)-p-(p)=10-17HCP, RESP: 2♣=range asks, CUE=STRONG STAY
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
1-Suit: PRE
2-Suit: 2NT=lowest suits weak or strong
Reopen: INTERMEDIATE
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
(1♣)-2♣=NAT; (1♣)-2♦=MM wk or strong
(1x)-2x=55 w/higher suit
JUMP CUE ASKS STOPPER; (1♣)-3♣=NAT PRE
(1♦)-p-(1M) 2♦=55, 2M=NAT
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
"LANDY-MULTI"
2♣=MM (2♦ asks better)
2♦=M (2M=P/C)
2M=5M+4m (2NT asks m, 3m NAT NF)
2NT=mm (over mini-NT NAT 17-19HCP)
DBL=PEN
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
T/O DBL+LEBENSÖHL
(3m)-4♣ - strong one-suiter; 4♦=MM; 4M=M+om
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
DBL=MM; 1NT=♣ or ♦; 2♦=♥ or ♠; 2M=5M+4m
RANDOM PRE
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
CAPPILETTI TRANSFERS from 1NT
New suit at 1st level F1

Can be light with classic shape, CUE=F2NT			
Pass is neutral over 1 level RDBL, higher is PEN			
(1♣)-DBL-(PASS)-1♦=0-6HCP any shape, others F1			
SPECIAL, ARTIFICIAL & COMPETITIVE DBLS/RDLS			
RESP and CARD-SHOWUNG DOUBLES			
SUPPORT DBL/RDBL below 3 of OPENER suit			
1m-(1♥)-DBL=4+♠			
1m-(1♠)-DBL-(2♠)-DBL=4♥, min			
Most low-level DBLs=T/O			
After 1m and COMP action DBL of 3M often asks stopper

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
2/1 GF, 5-card majors, 1m=3+
2♣=GF or wk 2♦; 2♦=18-19 BAL
T-walsh resp over 1♣
Frequent TRF sequences
Negative free bids at 2nd level
1NT Openings: 15-17
2 OVER 1 Resp: GF
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
op1. 2♣=GF or wk 2♦, decent 5-card is possible
op2. 2♦=18-19 BAL, no 5M/6m
op3. 2M=wk2, decent 5-card is possible
resp1. TRF resp over 1♣
resp2. 1M-3x=6+x INV
resp3. 1M-2NT=LIMIT RAISE, 1x-3x=PRE
comp1. Two-suited bids over OPP 1NT overcall
comp2. LEBENSÖHL, SCRAMBLING 2NT
comp3. TRF over takeout DBL starts at 1NT
comp4. NEGATIVE FREE BIDS and COMP TRF
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
After RDBL-SUPPORT below 2 in RESP suit (DBLs=PEN)
(1NT)-DBL-(2m)-PASS is forcing (DBL=T/O)
IMPORTANT NOTES
Usually we open higher suit with 65
PSYCHICS: tactical non-specific
